

Local System Settings for Running MCD etendering Application

1. Setting up Internet Explorer browser on your Computer System
 - ✓ Open Internet Explorer browser on your Computer
 - ✓ Go to Menu Bar -> click on Tools ->click on Internet Options
 - ✓ Click on Security tab ->click on Trusted Sites -> click on Sites button (below).
 - ✓ A new window will get opened.
 - ✓ Add Tick Mark appearing ahead of Require Server Verification (https:) for all sites in this zone.
 - ✓ Add website address – https://*.mcdetenders.com in Add this website to the zone:. If the website address is successfully added, you will see the address of the website in the box given.
 - ✓ Click on Close. Trusted sites window will get closed.
 - ✓ Now, click on Custom Level button. Security Settings – Trusted Sites Zone window will get opened.
 - ✓ Click on Reset to: drop down menu-> select the Low option -> click on Reset button. A warning message will appear. Click on Yes.
 - ✓ Now, click on OK. Security Settings window will get closed.
 - ✓ Now, click on Apply and, then click on OK.
2. Regional Settings on Computer System
 - ✓ Click on Control Panel in Start Menu.
 - ✓ Select Region and Language settings option.
 - ✓ Select language under Format: drop down box as English (United States).
 - ✓ Set Short Date: as MM/DD/YYYY.
 - ✓ Set Long Date: as Month, Day, Year.
 - ✓ Click on Apply and, then click OK.
3. User Account Settings
 - For Windows Vista
 - ✓ Click on Control Panel in Start Menu.
 - ✓ Select User Accounts.
 - ✓ Select Turn User Account Control On and Off.
 - ✓ Uncheck Use User Account Control (UNC) to help protect you control.
 - For Windows 7
 - ✓ Click on Control Panel in Start Menu.
 - ✓ Select User Accounts and Family Safety.
 - ✓ Select User Accounts.
 - ✓ Select Change User Account Control Settings.
 - ✓ Set it to Never Notify.

Note:

- ♣ Users Procuring digital Certificate Needs to Ensure that they procure a pair of two certificates one for the purpose of Digital Signature, Non-Repudiation and another for Key Encipherment
- ♣ No changes to be made by the Users using Windows XP except as mentioned below.
Minimum requirement for usage of SHA-2 Digital Signature Certificates

1. Minimum OS Requirements:

- ♣ Windows XP (Service Pack 3)
- ♣ Windows Vista - Business, Enterprise and Ultimate editions.
- ♣ Windows 7 - Professional, Enterprise and Ultimate editions

2. Browser Requirement: Internet Explorer 7 and above
